(late comer candidates after 11.00 A.M. will not be entertained) to fill up **two posts of Physician-Scientist 'B' (Medical) and one post of Dental-Scientist-B** on contract basis for six months on a consolidated salary of Rs.55,913/-p.m. at the Institute of Cytology & Preventive Oncology, Noida.

Post No.1 Physician-Scientist-B - (Two posts)

Essential qualifications & Experience:

MBBS recognised by MCI from a recognized University with 2 years experience, post MBBS in Community Medicine/Obstetrics and Gynaecology/Surgery).

Desirable qualifications:

- (i) MD (Obstetrics and Gynaecology)/Community Medicine/MS (Surgery).
- (ii) Additional Post doctoral research/teaching experience in relevant subjects in recognized institute(s).
- (iii) Knowledge of Computer Applications.
- (iv) Two years R&D/Teaching experience in relevant subject after obtaining essential qualifications.

Notes:

- (i) PhD or MD in relevant subjects shall be treated equivalent to three years experience respectively.
- (ii) Candidates with MD/MDS or Ph.D. degree will be preferred.

Job Requirements: -

The candidate should be able to carry out cancer screening activities in the camp set up in rural areas and should be willing to get involved in the training of paramedical workers in the field of cancer screening. The candidate should be willing for both field and clinic based work.

- (iii) Knowledge of Computer Applications.
- (iv) Two years R&D/Teaching experience in relevant subject after obtaining essential qualifications.

Job Requirements: -

The candidate should be able to carry out oral cancer screening activities in the camp set up in rural areas and should be willing to get involved in the training of paramedical workers in the field of cancer screening. The candidate should be willing for both field and clinic based work.

Age limit:

Not exceeding 35 years as on the date of walk in interview. Relaxable up to 5 years for Government servants and SC/ST and 3 years for OBC Candidates in accordance with the instructions issued by the Department of Personnel and Training from time to time in this regard.

Applications are invited up to **10.3.2016** for one post of **Scientist 'D' (Community Medicine)** at the Institute of Cytology & Preventive Oncology, Noida in the Pay Band PB-3 of Rs.15600–39100 + Grade Pay Rs.7600 and usual allowances as admissible as per Government norms.

Essential Qualification & Experience:

Post Graduate degree in Community Medicine/PSM/Epidemiology recognized by MCI with five years R&D/teaching experience or Postgraduate diploma in Community Medicine/PSM/Epidemiology with six years R&D/teaching experience in the relevant subject from recognized University (out of which 2 years in a Managerial position to handle R&D projects in a team effectively in a directing capacity).

Or

MBBS degree recognized by MCI or equivalent degree from recognized University with 8 years R&D/Teaching experience in the Community Medicine/PSM/Epidemiology subject after MBBS Degree, out of which 2 years in a Managerial position to handle R&D projects in a team effectively in a directing capacity.

Desirable Qualification:

- (i) Doctorate in Community Medicine from a recognized university.
- (ii) Additional Post doctoral research/teaching experience from recognized institute(s).
- (iii) Knowledge of Computer Applications.

Job Requirements:

The candidate should be able to provide good leadership in planning and carrying out research in the field of cancer prevention with emphasis on cytopathological, molecular and epidemiological aspects of different types of cancers chosen by the Institute as a priority. He/She should be able to carry out various teaching & training programmes in the field of Community Medicine/PSM/Epidemiology.

Age limit:

- (i) Not exceeding 45 years. Relaxable up to 5 years for Government servants and SC/ST and 3 years for OBC candidates in accordance with the instructions issued by the Department of Personnel and Training from time to time in this regard. However, the prescribed age may be further relaxed in exceptional cases for experienced and qualified candidates.
- (ii) Age, qualification and Experience will be relaxable in deserving cases as per the Recruitment Rules of Health Research Scientists cadre of ICMR under Rule 14 and Note:1 & 2 of Schedule-III.
- (iii) One time age relaxation is also allowed to Scientific and Technical Staff working in long-term projects in ICMR/Centres for posts advertised under HRSC, 2007 provided they meet essential qualifications and experience for the post with a view to provide them opportunity to compete with other candidates as per Council's letter No.6/1/2007-Admn.II dated 28.3.2011

Other Service Conditions:

1. Allowances as per Central Govt. Rules are admissible on the above pay scale.
2. Benefits of new restructured defined contributory Pension system are admissible as per the provision contained in the Ministry of Finance, Department of Economic Affairs (ECB & PR Division), Notification No.5/7/2003-ECB & PR dated 22/12/2003 effective from 01/01/2004.
3. Private practice is not allowed. However, non-practising allowance is admissible to medical graduates only as per rules.
4. Applications from employees working in Central/State Govt. Departments, Public Sector Undertakings and Government funded research agencies must be forwarded through proper channel. Advance copies of application will be considered subject to the conditions that a “No Objection Certificate” from the employer is produced at the time of personal discussion.
